

## Nikos Zacharias



Nikos Zacharias (chemical engineer, dipl. PhD) is Professor at the University of Peloponnese and Director of the Laboratory of Archaeometry. His field is the use of luminescence for dating and authenticity testing of archaeological and geological materials, the analytical characterization of glasses and pottery and environmental dosimetry studies. He worked at Bonn University, at TEI Piraeus and at NCSR Demokritos (12 years). N.Z. is author of 15 books and book-chapters and coauthored over 120 scientific communications. He is editor in archaeometry for the Mediterranean Archaeology and Archaeometry journal, chaired 6 international symposia and has participated at 25 national and EU funded research programs. NZ presented 175 papers at international symposia, has a total of 473 citations in peer-reviewed literature (source: Scopus) and an h-factor of 13 (September 2017).
